

## Functionality of the Template:

This template extends everything that was used on the BratMUN website and extends it to a new version. The basic principle behind it is that, whether logged in or not, the language icons in the top-right corner of the screen switch the user between languages. Once the user is in a language, he or she will stay in that language until the user changes the language. That way the administrator can switch between languages regardless of whether he is on the website or in the administration section and edit them accordingly.


Graphics is kept to a minimum, since the client will usually gradually make up his mind and it is virtually impossible to guess the most appropriate design before actually talking to the client.

Once logged in as administrator, small [Edit] buttons appear next to all editable sections of the page:



Once clicked, the respective page will be loaded into a WYSIWYG editor on a different page and will enable editing. Once you are done editing the page, you can click Save, and the page will be saved with the current changes. Pressing Reset will reload the page as it was before you started editing and pressing Go Back (Do not save) returns you back to the initial page without saving any changes.
